Q. What is the XTRAC® Excimer Laser?

A. The XTRAC® Excimer Laser is an exciting new treatment for psoriasis. The XTRAC Excimer Laser is designed to provide fast, effective relief from dry, itchy and unsightly psoriasis lesions.



Q. How does the XTRAC Laser work?

A. Using a carefully focused beam of laser light delivered through an advanced technology light guide device, the XTRAC Excimer Laser system can treat psoriasis lesions quickly and effectively. The XTRAC Laser concentrates the light only on the psoriasis lesion, allowing the physician to deliver high doses necessary for rapid clearing while minimizing exposure of healthy skin.

Q. What is an XTRAC Laser treatment session like?

A. Treatments are fast, easy and performed in a physician's office. On the first visit, the physician will determine your optimal starting dose. Then the physician or a trained health care professional will hold the XTRAC hand piece over the affected area(s) and expose the lesions to the laser light. Depending on the size of the affected area, this takes only a few minutes and requires no anesthesia.

Q. Does XTRAC Laser treatment hurt?

A. Most patients feel no pain or discomfort during the quick XTRAC Laser sessions. Occasionally, some patients report a warm sensation, similar to a mild sunburn, at the treatment site.

Q. How many XTRAC Laser treatments does it take and what results can I expect?

A. Individual results will vary depending on the body surface affected. Most patients experience significant improvement in a few as 6 to 10 treatments; clearance in 10 to 20 depending on the severity.

Q. How long will a remission last?

A. Average remissions times of 3.5 to 6 months have been reported.

Q. Who should consider XTRAC Excimer Laser treatment?

A. Individuals with mild to moderate psoriasis that are unhappy with their current method of treatment or who have failed previous treatment options should consider the XTRAC Excimer Laser treatment. This includes individuals who have tried topical treatments, oral medications, injections and traditional phototherapy and have areas not responding to those treatments. The XTRAC Laser is perfect for active people who want fast, convenient treatment.

Q. Is XTRAC Laser treatment covered by insurance?

A. The XTRAC Excimer Laser treatment for psoriasis is generally covered by Medicare and most major insurance plans, but it is best to check with your insurance company to see if this treatment is covered under your plan and to see if there are any additional coverage criteria or, call the XTRAC Laser Insurance Help Line at **877-44-XTRAC**.
